CRITICAL INCIDENT AT OVERTURE DAY PROGRAM



Day program staff were on an outing in the community when a high stakes emergency arose



Staff responded appropriately to protect the safety of all people involved



A complaint survey was conducted



Post survey cycle commenced including a POC

OVERTURE'S RESPONSE TO CRITICAL INCIDENT AND CDPHE REVIEW

Followed all the typical responses listed previously with one big exception....

WE DIDN'T TERMINATE THE STAFF INVOLVED


Reasoning:

- The DSP was not acting in a manner that went against policy or protocol.
- The DSP acted as needed in the moment and as they were trained.
- Overture did have some system failures that needed to be addressed, this was not the DSP's fault.
