FY 24-25 Proposed Rate Increases

All rate increases shown are proposed in the Governor's budget and are not yet final [Updated 2.21.24]

HCBS BASE WAGE

This year, the Gov. proposes giving base wage increases *plus* the common policy increase to the following services

Counties struggle to keep up

Case Management (CM) Redesign and New CM System

CCB/SEPs began to transfer case management functions to new Case Management Agencies (CMAs) and HCPF implemental a new CM data system.

Billing Delays

Due to the PHE Unwind, CMRD, the new CM system, and workforce crisis, providers are seeing significant billing delays and CMAs are overworked.

HCPF gave 60-day extension for HCBS.

October-November 2023.
