

Federal Stimulus Payment Guide



Individual

For individuals with incomes less than \$75,000 and who filed an income tax return with the IRS for 2018 or 2019

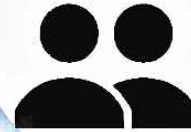
\$1,200



Head of Household

For heads of household with incomes less than \$112,500 and who filed an income tax return with the IRS for 2018 or 2019

\$1,200



Couple

For couples with incomes less than \$150,000 and who filed an income tax return with the IRS for 2018 or 2019

\$2,400



Kids

For every child under the age of 17

\$500/ea



No Tax Return?

You might still get a check!

If you have not filed taxes for either 2018 or 2019, you can:

File now! Even with an income of \$1, you may still qualify or

Claim the refund when you file your 2020 taxes **next year**



Earn more than the limit?

You may still get a check!

For incomes above the threshold, payments are reduced by \$5 for every additional \$100 of income

For example:
A couple (without kids) earning more than \$198,000 would **not** receive a check



Retired?

You may still get a check!

The IRS will use your Social Security form 1099 to process your payment



How do you make a claim?

You don't!

Checks will auto-deposit into your bank account **if** you direct deposited your tax refund or
or
be mailed to the address on your most recent tax filing or social security benefit statement
