



Alliance Statement on Early Intervention RFP Process

As the Department of Early Childhood embarks on a Request for Proposals for Early Intervention Service Brokers, Alliance urges the Department to ensure that children and families who are enrolled or eligible are not negatively impacted. When systems changes occur, they may create barriers to, and gaps in, services. Given the short window during which children and families can access Early Intervention, preventing such barriers, gaps, or delays is paramount. We therefore urge the Department to create contingency plans to ensure that children and families can continue to receive services without disruption during this time. Alliance and its members are happy to assist the Department in thinking through potential unintended consequences and contingency plans.
